Section 160 Definition of Economically Disadvantaged Community

(a) IN GENERAL. Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall issue guidance defining the term "economically disadvantaged community" for the purposes of this Act and the amendments made by this Act.

(b) CONSIDERATIONS. In defining the term "economically disadvantaged community" under subsection (a), the Secretary shall, to the maximum extent practicable, utilize the criteria under paragraph (1) or (2) of section 301(a) of the Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3161), to the extent that such criteria are applicable in relation to the development of water resources development projects.

(c) PUBLIC COMMENT. In developing the guidance under subsection (a), the Secretary shall provide notice and an opportunity for public comment.

§ 3161. Eligibility of areas

(a) In general

For a project to be eligible for assistance under section 3141 or 3149 of this title, the project shall be located in an area that, on the date of submission of the application, meets 1 or more of the following criteria:

(1) Low per capita income

The area has a per capita income of 80 percent or less of the national average.

(2) Unemployment rate above national average

The area has an unemployment rate that is, for the most recent 24-month period for which data are available, at least 1 percent greater than the national average unemployment rate.





An economically disadvantaged community is defined as meeting one or more of the following:

a. Low per capita income - The area has a per capita income of 80 percent or less of the national average;

b. Unemployment rate above national average - The area has an unemployment rate that is, for the most recent 24-month period for which data are available, at least 1 percent greater than the national average unemployment rate;

c. Indian country as defined in 18 U.S.C. 1151 or in the proximity of an Alaska Native Village; d. U.S. Territories; or

e. Communities identified as disadvantaged by the Council on Environmental Quality's Climate and Economic Justice Screening Tool (https://screeningtool.geoplatform.gov).
